Please note: these are written in the first person so you can apply them directly to your life – the corresponding Bible verses are listed after each statement so you can learn/memorize the verse.

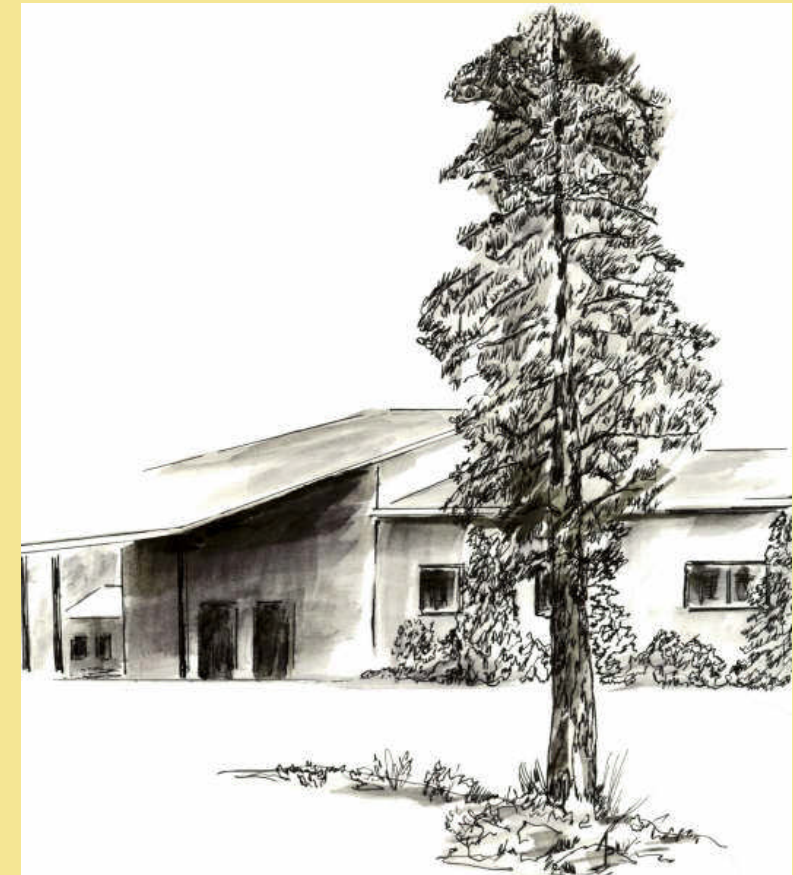
I speak soft answers that turn away wrath, not grievous words that stir up anger. PROVERBS 15:1
