Please note: these are written in the first person so you can apply them directly to your life – the corresponding Bible verses are listed after each statement so you can learn/memorize the verse.

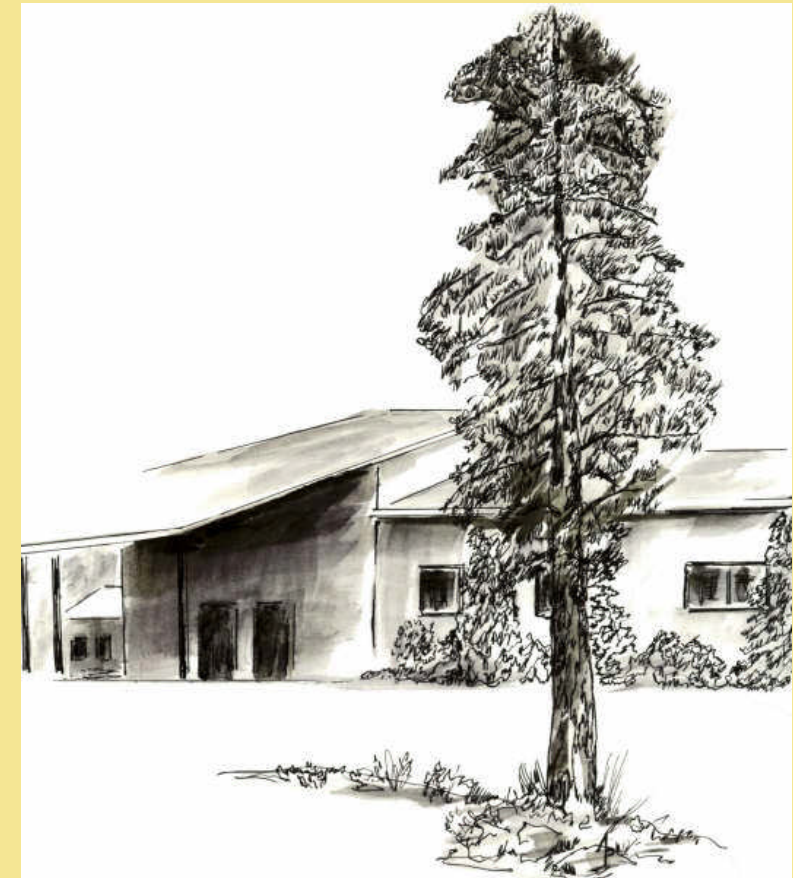
I am not quick in spirit to be angry or vexed, for anger and vexation lodge in the bosom of fools. ECCLESIASTES 7:9
